#### **Margaret Elizabeth Anthoney**

This is Margaret "Peggy" Elizabeth Anthoney.

She disappears from the family after the 1860 South Carolina census, and is not listed with the family in 1870. Larkin marries again in 1870, so the assumption is that Peggy died sometime before 1870, but I have found no reference, documentation, or grave for her in my research that would confirm her death; but I did find at one time an individual that could have been her listed in a later census record with who might have been a possibly grand-daughter and her husband. I made a note of it to remind me to research further, but I have not been able to locate the note or to find the same census listing again. It all makes me think that Larkin could have abandoned (divorced) Peggy.

#### **John McGinnis**

Enlisted in Co. G, 60th Reg., NC Troops in Polk Co. at age 32 on Aug. 29, 1862, died in Ringgold, Catoosa Springs, Georgia, February 13, 1863 of "dysentery", and possibly buried there, but there is the story that his father Larkin and brother James went to retrieve his body and returned it to Polk Co. and buried him in the

Green River Baptist cemetery; there is a headstone for him there beside his wife Alicia and Alicia's second husband, Calvin Painter.

**James McGinnis**

Notes on the Hyder-Searcy family records published in the Gen. Society of Old Tryon Co. Bulletin says that a daughter of Let Hyder married a "Lum" McGinnis. This could of course be this James since he named his first born son Columbus; meaning that this James' name would most probably have been James Columbus McGinnis.

James Columbus McGinnis was also a name given to the son of Andrew, which would have been this James' grandson.

**Sarah McGinnis**

There is a Sarah A. McGinnas married a Michael Mauney in Gaston Co. on Dec. 11, 1867.

This Sarah does not appear to be a party to the 1883 legal suit against her step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis regarding Larkin's estate.

---

**Mary Elvira McGinnis**

The name Mary Alvira is taken from marriage license.

There is a Mary E. Walker (widow) listed in the 1880 Polk Co. census with sister (shown as daughter) Emily McGinnis (22) and sister Nancy E. McGinnis (24).

Elvira Walker is listed as a party in the suit against step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis.

There is confusion on this individual since in the 1860 South Carolina census it lists both a Elvira, age 26, and a Mary E. McGinnis, age 24 as two separate daughters of Larkin and Margt. McGunies.

**Relationship Notes for Wiley S. Walker and Mary Elvira McGinnis**

This could have been a Polk Co. marriage.

---

**Mary E. McGinnis**

There is a Mary E. Walker (widow) listed in the 1880 Polk Co. census with sister (shown as daughter) Emily McGinnis (22) and sister Nancy E. McGinnis (24). There is still confusion on this individual since I show a Mary Alvira McGinnis marrying a Wiley S. Walker, so I don't know if this is the same person or not.

There is Elvira Walker listed in 1883 legal action against step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis, but not a Mary.

---

**Eliza B. McGinnis**

There is a Eliza McGinnis (born in Rutherford Co.) listed as spouse of a Dyle Harden on a Cleveland Co. death certificate of a Caroline Arnold, 16 July 1916. Caroline is listed as born about 1860 and widowed.

1870 Cleveland Co. Census has a D.D. and Louisa Harden with daughter Caroline. Also listed with the family is a W.T. McGinnis, who could be the brother to Louisa. although his age was listed at 17 and does not match. Louisa's age is listed as 36, which would make birth year as 1834.

1880 Cleveland Co. Census has a Davey D. and Louisa Hardin with daughter Caroline. Louisa's age is listed as 48, which would make her birth around 1832.

There is a Cleveland Co. marriage document dated 14 Dec. 1862 between a D. D. Hardin and Louisa McGinnis.

This Eliza does not appear to be a party to the 1883 legal suit against her step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis regarding Larkin's estate.

---

**William C. McGinnis**

This individual is listed as both William C. and William T. in documents. This William appears to not be a party to the suit brought against step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis for estate of father Larkin.

---

**Joseph McGinnis**

The only clear documentation that I have found of this Joseph is in the 1860 South Carolina census of Larkin and Margt. McGuines.

This Joseph does not appear to be a party to the 1883 legal suit against the step-mother Elizabeth Walker

**Osborn Landrum McGinnis**

Looks like Osborn L. and Rachel were in Colorado in 1910 census.

---

**Audern McGinnis**

Possibly name is Andrew.

This individual does not appear to be a party to the 1883 legal suit against the step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis regarding Larkin's estate.

---

**Margaret Ann McGinnis**

This could be the Ann McGinnis marrying Henry Hall, Polk Co., 19 May 1872. Shown as daughter of Larkin and Margarete.

Death date with "find a grave" is given as Sept. 27, 1929.

---

**Nancy Elizabeth McGinnis**

Tombstone shows birthdate as November 27, 1856.

---

**Emma McGinnis**

Possibly also known as Emmaline or Emily.

This individual does not appear to be a party to the 1883 legal suit against her step-mother Elizabeth Walker McGinnis regarding Larkin's estate.

---

**William T. McGinnis**

Shown as deaf and dumb in the 1880 Polk Co. census.
